CHAIR'S NOTES NOVEMBER 2017

Hampshire County Council Highways recently commissioned a report on options for the management of traffic arising from the new housing development at Boorley Green.

One option was to block off Wangfield Lane at the river or thereabouts. We suggested that blocking at the new junction on Maddoxford Lane would be more appropriate.

However, the Council have now concluded that it would be more sensible to monitor traffic on these lanes and others over the next few vears, as the number of houses grows, before coming to a conclusion.

The proposed Botley bypass will also affect traffic flows when completed.

Curdridge Lane is already busy with traffic, including lorries, and is likely to become more so as a significant number of new houses are about to be built in Waltham Chase.

Unfortunately we were not consulted on the plans for these developments as they are outside of our Parish. However, we are now taking measures to try to

ensure that in future we are kept informed about plans for larger developments within immediately neighbouring parishes that will clearly affect us.
