Planning Decisions and Appeal Notifications:

Bridge House Botley Road Curbridge SO30 2HB - Replacement dwelling together with associated access and landscaping. Case Officer: Lisa Booth. Case No: 19/00360/FUL. Application WITHDRAWN.

Poplars Farm Curdrige Lane Curdrige SO32 2BH - Change of use of buildings to B2 (General Industrial) (retrospective). Case Officer: Rose Lister. Case No: 19/00540/FUL. Application PERMITTED.

The Barn Harmsworth Farm Botley Road Curbridge Southampton Hampshire - Proposed erection of a detached building for use as a fitness suite, that is incidental to enjoyment of the dwelling house. Case No: 17/02085/LDP. An appeal has been made to the Secretary of State against the decision of Winchester City Council to refuse/refused to grant a certificate of lawful use or development.
