### **BURIAL AUTHORITY FOR THE PARISH OF CURDRIDGE TABLE OF CHARGES FROM 1 APRIL 2024 TO 31 MARCH 2025**

**(NB: excludes any charges for labour, grave digging and the Minister's fee – all Applicants MUST also read and comply with Curdridge Parish Burials Rules and Regulations)**

#### **INTERMENTS**

<b>1</b>	The body of a stillborn child or a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 6 months	<b>No Charge</b>
<b>2</b>	The body of a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 12 years.	<b>£110.00</b>
<b>3</b>	The body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 12 years (to include levelling of grave after 12 months)	<b>£250.00</b>
<b>4</b>	Cremated remains.	<b>£150.00</b>

#### **EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF BURIAL**

<b>1</b>	In an adult grave	<b>£250.00</b>
<b>2</b>	In a Child grave	<b>£50.00</b>
<b>3</b>	In a cremation plot	<b>£110.00</b>

#### **HEADSTONES, VASES, TABLETS AND MEMORIAL INSCRIPTONS**

Headstones	<b>£150.00</b>
Vases	<b>£50.00</b>
Additional inscriptions	<b>FREE</b>
Replacement Memorial fee	<b>£50.00</b>
Transfer of Exclusive Right of Burial	<b>£25.00</b>

A reasonable sized vase or urn may be used instead of a headstone. These may only be placed at the head of the grave where the headstone would normally be sited.

**PARISHIONERS:** Due to the severe shortage of burial plots within Curdridge Parish Council's Cemetery only residents who have lived in a domestic dwelling within the parish for the past 10 years (prior to their death) will be allowed to be buried within the cemetery's burial plots. Anyone who had been moved to a rest home within another parish long term will have to have lived within Curdridge Parish at least five times longer than they had resided in a rest home outside of the parish. NB: This clause will not apply to burial plots previously reserved and interments into those burial plots. New cremation plots are to be established and will come into use once all the cremation plots in St Peters Church have been used. Residents wishing to be interred into these cremation plots must have lived within the parish for the past 7 years (prior to their death). Anyone who had been moved to a rest home within another parish long term will have to have lived within Curdridge Parish at least five times longer than they had resided in a rest home outside of the parish

**NON PARISHIONERS:** Double fees apply for former long term residents of the parish who had lived in the parish for at least ten years prior to moving directly into a Retirement Home, Nursing Homes and/or Hospitals outside of the parish in recent years (due to health requirements).

Plot reservations are currently only allowed in **exceptional circumstances**, where a person has currently lived long-term within the parish far in excess of ten years and also retains a very strong historical family connection to the parish.
